



Pilot Implementation Plan

The CCC Framework Pilot Implementation Plan provides a structured approach for introducing transparency, communication, informed conservation, and trust-building practices within dental clinics and oral-health organizations.

Phase 1: Staff Training and Orientation

Train providers and staff on CCC Framework principles, patient-centered communication, cost transparency, and informed-conservation practices.

Phase 2: Deployment of CCC Tools

Implement the Patient Transparency Assessment Form, After-Visit Survey, Self-Assessment Tool, and Preventive-Care resources.

Phase 3: Data Collection and Monitoring

Collect anonymous patient feedback and monitor quality metrics related to patient understanding, trust, communication, and satisfaction.

Phase 4: Quality Improvement Review

Review aggregated results, identify communication gaps, and implement corrective actions to improve patient-centered care.

- Enhanced informed-conservation effectiveness
- Greater patient trust and engagement
- Increased preventive-care awareness
